

# Oamaru Steampunk Festival 2019 Performance Info

## Fri 31 May

- 4.30pm: tech rehearsal for Vaudeville
- 6.30pm: first performance at Fire & Steam
- 7.15pm: second performance at Fire & Steam
- 8.30pm: Vaudeville Show starts, we are in 2<sup>nd</sup> half

## Sat 1 June

- 10.30am: Steampunk Parade
- After the parade: photoshoot
- 3.30pm: Steampunk Belly Dance Workshop

## Vaudeville Tech Rehearsal

This will be at the Vaudeville venue The Scottish Hall, 10 Tyne St, Oamaru.

Time 4.30pm so we can do the tech run then head over to Fire & Steam as they are 5mins walk apart. We can leave our costumes etc at the hall while we perform at Fire & Steam.

This is an outdoor event held along Harbour St which is the main Victorian Precinct St in Oamaru.

We've got 2 x 15min sets booked, first at **6.30pm then at 7.15pm** in front of the main stage which is at the end of Harbour St that intersects with Wansbeck St.

Some dancers from Dunedin will be joining us.

You don't need to pay the admission, just say you are performing.

Please bring zills, Isis Wings & pixel whips (no swords) – I haven't got a specific pixel whip track in, we can just bust them out for a jam to whatever the band is playing before or after us.

### **Set 1**

- Follow along 'warm up' track for whoever is available
- Dunedin Dancers
- All in chorus line

### **Set 2**

- Isis Wings Superstylin' main section
- All in chorus line
- Skirt track

We'll add in an Isis Wings practice next 2 x Thur night for those who want to join in.

### **Costume**

- Stef skirts (spares available, sing out if you need one)
- Any straight Tribal Style belt (mirror/coin/embroidery etc, not fusion style or white)
- Warm leggings/thermals
- Shoes you can dance in – ideally black/dark & in keeping with your costume i.e. not sneakers
- As many long sleeve tops/thermals as you want to wear with a black top layer
- Either a vest (steampunk style or plain) if you have one or a jacket that you can dance in or the plain black top layer
- Jewelry just whatever you fancy/fits etc as we're pretty covered anyway
- Makeup ready for Vaudeville – stage makeup including dark/sparkly eyes & lipstick
- Hair ready for Vaudeville – whatever flower garden you fancy with a preference for warm/sparkly flowers

### **Vaudeville**

Show starts at 8.30pm we are in the second half. We'll head over as soon as we finish at Fire & Steam – it's 5mins walk between the two.

### **Set**

- Pixel Whips entry piece around the hall/onstage (Inxtruxx)
- Tracey 2min solo – get to where you need to be for main track
- Steampunk Fusion (Walla Walla)

### **Costume**

- White fluffy skirt
- Black over skirt
- Brocade or Medanz pantaloons
- Steampunk copper/brinze/gold/black/white belt with embellishments
- Black cross-back top
- Bra that either can't be seen under your top at the back or has cross back ties – just so as not obviously 'underwear'
- Stage makeup including dark/sparkly eyes & lipstick
- Hair - whatever flower garden you fancy with a preference for warm/sparkly flowers
- Masks
- Donna's elusive chokers + whatever earrings/bracelets etc take your fancy with a preference for silver/gold/sparkly/steampunk inspired
- New bindis from Tracey if she gets a chance to make them ;)

### **Steampunk Parade**

Starts at 10.30am, assemble from 10am on Wansbeck St

Costume same as for Fire & Steam, don't worry about full on makeup if you don't want to but do wear some for the photoshoot afterwards.

We'll likely be dancing to my portable stereo.

Performance is pretty casual – we're moving pretty much the whole time so just follow the person at the front & take a break as you like.

### **Photoshoot**

Stand around looking awesome for a while wherever the parade finishes up....
